1. This company was first organized on 26 March 1929 and activated as Company A, 16th Medical Regiment. It was subsequently redesignated 401st Medical Collecting Company and Company A, 51st Armored Medical Battalion.

2. Unit was finally designated as the 501st Armored Medical Company on 20 October 1951 under TO&E 8-77N, dated 12 May 1948, and DA Circular 10, 1951 per GO 61, Headquarters, Seventh Army, dated 16 October 1951. Unit was reorganized 15 August 1953 under TO&E 8-77, dated 24 September 1952, and DA Circular 72, 1952, per GO 55, Headquarters, Seventh Army, dated 12 August 1953.

3. Unit was again reorganized under TO&E 8-77R, dated 10 February 1955, per GO 79, Headquarters, USAREUR, which it is presently operating under.

4. There is nothing on file in regards to information pertaining to Unit Battle Order.

5. Attached unit history is only history available pertaining to this unit.

501ST ARMORED MEDICAL COMPANY

The company was first constituted on 26 March 1929, and activated as Company A, 16th Medical Regiment. It was subsequently redesignated 401st Medical Collecting Company, and Company A, 51st Armored Medical Battalion. On 20 October 1951, at Wursburg, Germany, per General Order #61, Headquarters, Seventh Army, dated 16 October 1951, it was finally designated as the 501st Armored Medical Company.

This unit is credited with participation in the Tunisia, North Apennines, and Po Valley campaigns during World War II. It was awarded a meritorious unit commendation for service in the European Theater by General Orders #113, Fifth Army, dated 10 September 1945.
